Our goal was to help a few women and their children obtain affordable health care.

We found there was a real need to help women and their families. Obtaining affordable health care is just one component that is so crucial for families on their path to becoming self-sufficient. Not only do we help people find health care but, by partnering with over 30 diverse community organizations, we connect them and their families with other services such as food stamps, housing resources and clinics. So far, our efforts have touched over 200,000 lives.

But the needs are greater than ever and it's time to do more.
